

Ice Rink.

Winter 2013-2014 was an exciting year for the Wainwright complex due to the fact that its first ever public ice rink was built. The rink is 108 feet wide and 212 feet long. There are scheduled activities, such as non-contact pond hockey, and free skating. A ribbon ceremony was held on February 1, 2014 at the 2nd annual Winterfest carnival. The rink was funded through the South Portland- Cape Elizabeth Rotary Club and a \$15,000 donation from the Port Harbor Marina and Soucy family. Lights were also installed so that community members could participate in nighttime skating activities.

Ski trail.

Wainwright offers ski trails as another form of passive recreation for the community. The trails can be used for cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and walking. In addition to the trails the City of South Portland has a 9-hole Municipal Golf Course. The golf course and trails have provided alternate forms of recreation that the town had previously been lacking.
