



RE-OPENING MAY 15th

TEE TIMES REQUIRED

Good Afternoon,

The South Portland Municipal Golf Course will re-open on May 15th under restrictive measures being required by Governor Mills. Our course has implemented a number of policies and procedures to help protect golfers and staff and for our course to remain open. These policies will be strictly enforced and anyone intentionally disregarding them may be asked to vacate the premises.

Please review these policies and procedures before coming to play golf at our facility.

COVID-19 Reopening Phase 1 Guidelines 2020

- Strict social distancing is to be practiced per CDC guidelines, <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>
- NO UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY INTO CLUBHOUSE, STAFF ONLY.
- Clubhouse closed to public, meaning no sale of food, rental clubs, pull carts, or merchandise.
- No access to restrooms at clubhouse or on the course.
- Tee times are required, 20 minute increments, **MAXIMUM 18 HOLES PLAY**, maximum of 4 players per tee time.
- Call Clubhouse for tee times (207-775-0005). No walk-ups allowed, must have tee time.
- Tee times can be made no more than 48 hours in advance.
- **For tee times on May 15th, you may call the clubhouse on May 13 & 14 between the hours of 8am-4pm to schedule. A staff member will be available to assist you.**
- Course will be open from 8:00 AM- 6:00 PM (month of May.)

- Last available daily tee time will be 20 minutes (ex. 5:40 PM) prior to Clubhouse closing time.
- Golfers may be paired up (via assigned tee times) with other golfers based on tee time openings.
- No loitering on patio area or parking lot(s).
- Payment must be made by credit card or 10-play or 5-play punch card only at the window to the right of the clubhouse door. NO CASH.
- Rates are as same as last season.
- 2020 season 10-play and 5-play punch cards are available for sale at Clubhouse.
- No scorecards or pencils.
- Flags are to stay in the cups, also cups will be raised and no access to ball washers or bunker rakes.
